## Wowrack interconnect revision

This document serves as a revision to the Wowrack existing interconnect with the SIX, dated April 11<sup>th</sup> 2017, pending approval by the SIX Board. We are providing the information based on the SIX policies and rules at <a href="https://www.seattleix.net/rules">https://www.seattleix.net/rules</a>.

Wowrack need to add its existing SIX extension switches on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor with Dell Force10 S4810 switch as it provides more capacity and flexibility with its SFP/SFP+ ports. We also replacing the SIX extension switch on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor from a Force10 S25 to Force10 S4810, in the end this process will add more capacity and flexibility for SIX participants who wish to connect with copper or fiber cross-connect through Wowrack SIX Extension.

SIX policy and rules will be enforced on this new switch. Ports will err-disable for the following reasons:

- Exceeding a maximum MAC count of one MAC address per VLAN
- BPDUs
